ANNEXURE 1

Section - 7 Cultural Centre Committee

7.1. Constitution of Cultural Centre Committee

- i. There shall be Cultural Centre Committee as an auxiliary of Bunts Sangha to manage and administer the affairs of cultural centre building and to maintain the said cultural centre building in good and tidy condition.
- ii. There shall be Cultural Centre Committee, which shall consist of President, Vice president (one), Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer of the Bunts Sangha. The President, Vice president, (one) & Secretary of the Bunts Sangha, shall be ex-officio Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary of Cultural Centre Committee, and other members of Cultural Centre Committee, initially, are to be from members of Bunts Sangha, Pune, who have contributed substantially by way of donation of Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs and above in kind or otherwise, has caused to have managed to get donation to the our Sangha, Rs. Twenty Five lakhs or above towards construction of Bunts Sangha Cultural Centre, being constructed at area of plot admeasuring about 2900 Sq. Mtrs., from and out of Gat No /Survey No.104 of Village: Baner, Tal: Haveli, Dist: Pune.
- iii. The first Cultural Centre Committee shall have consisted of members, who have been selected / nominated by Managing Committee from members of General body considering their enormous contribution in form of either substantial donations made to the Bunts Sangha, or hard work and possible endeavors towards construction of the Bunts Sangha's Cultural Centre in all respect.
- iv. The terms of members of Cultural Centre Committee shall be for sixteen (16) years subject to removal as per Clause No- 4 here-in-below mentioned.

7.2. Qualification of member of Cultural Centre Committee.

- i. The member of Cultural Centre Committee shall be member of Bunts Sangha, Pune.
- ii. The member of Cultural Centre Committee must have contributed towards upliftment and betterment of the members of Bunts Sangha in particular and members of Bunts Community in general and also, must have contributed and / or has caused to have contributed in form of substantial donations either in cash or in kind of Rs. Twenty Five Lakhs and above.
- iii. The member of Cultural Centre Committee shall be entitled to contest the election of Managing committee or any other Committee already constituted or to be constituted from time to time.
- iv. The member of present Committee shall be of good repute amongst the members of Bunts Sangha in particular, and members of Bunts community in general and shall be nominated by the members of Managing Committee by majority and shall be non-controversial.

7.3 Vesting of administration and management of Cultural Centre building:

- i. The Cultural Centre Committee shall be vested with exclusive power, function and authority to manage and administer all the affairs of cultural centre building and its maintenance etc.,
- ii. The Cultural Centre Committee shall function in co-ordination with the Managing committee and shall be subject to overall control of General Body.
- iii. The said Cultural Centre Committee shall be exclusively vested with the management and administration of the cultural centre and the Cultural Centre

- Committee shall have power to frame rules for administration and management of cultural centre or its part.
- iv. The Cultural Centre Committee shall have power and authority of advisory body and in case of purchase, sell, lease of property/s of Bunts Sangha, the Cultural Centre Committee shall have consulted by Managing Committee.
 - v. The decisions of cultural center committee shall be binding upon the members of Bunts Sangha, subject to approval of General Body and in case of any urgency, the only special General Body shall have power of veto or rejection of decision of cultural centre committee, however, the decision of the Cultural Centre Committee shall be restricted to, only management and administration of cultural centre, and also acquisition of property by sale, lease or otherwise, and in case of sale, lease of property of Bunts Sangha.
 - vi. It is mandatory for the Managing Committee to seek opinion and advice of cultural centre committee, in case of diversion of funds from income and surplus income/ Revenue of Cultural Centre Building to any other activity of Sangha and advice and opinion of Cultural Centre Committee shall be binding upon Managing Committee.

7.3. Filling of vacancy and Removal of Member of Cultural Centre Committee :

- i. The any of the members of Cultural Centre Committee shall be removed by General Body either by in Annual or Special meeting, by passing Resolution by at least 2/3 majority of the members present and voting thereon, and the person being removed shall have opportunity to present his case or explanation.
- ii. The member of the Cultural Centre Committee shall be ceased to be member of Cultural Centre Committee in following circumstances:
 1. By death,
 2. By resignation,
 3. By removal on the ground of commission of offences of moral turpitude by following procedure, enumerated in removal of member of managing committee.
 4. By unsoundness of mind.
- v. The vacancy/ies resulting from the reason mentioned in Para(ii) written hereinabove, shall be filled up by nomination by the Managing Committee by majority subject to qualification prescribed in clause 2 hereinabove.

7.4 Privileges of Member of Cultural Centre Committee:

- i. The member of Cultural Centre Committee shall have provided with priority seating in front of Section of Auditorium in Social gathering and functions of Bunts Sangha except private functions of members of bunts Sangha.
- ii. The member of Cultural Centre Committee shall have provided with priority car parking for their vehicles in all social functions of Bunts Sangha like – Annual General Meeting, Annual Gathering, Annual sport meet or any other social gathering organized by Bunts Sangha.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove in the provisions of Bunts Sangha, the decision of Cultural Centre Committee shall be final in case of management and administration of cultural centre.

7.5. Meeting of Cultural Centre Committee :

- i. The Cultural Centre Committee shall meet at least once in three months. The Chairman of Cultural Centre Committee shall preside over meeting of Cultural Centre Committee and in his absence, the Cultural Centre Committee shall have to elect Chairman amongst the members present and shall have to conduct meeting.

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- ii. The Quorum for the meeting of Cultural Centre Committee shall be ten and all the decisions of Cultural Centre Committee shall be by majority present.
- iii. The Cultural Centre Committee shall have to maintain minutes of its meeting and the secretary of the Cultural Centre Committee shall have to maintain the same.

**MINUTES OF THE 35TH ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD ON
11.10.2015 AT OUR CULTURAL CENTRE, PUNE - 411045.**

Meeting had begun with lighting the lamp along with devotional prayer songs & subsequently offered condolences for all the family members of our community who had lost their beloved ones by observing one minutes silence prayer.

1. Meeting called to order by president at 11 am sharp. Thereafter the meeting had been adjourned for an hour for want of quorum. At 12 pm, Again President had called the adjourned meeting to order and requested the Secretary to proceed further as per the agenda. Hon. President Shri Jagannath Shetty welcomed all the members for AGM 2015 & appreciated dynamic leadership of our young president Mr Santosh Shetty & team of Managing Committee for fast & steady progress of construction work of cultural centre & fund raising activities. He requested all members to support this project by donating generously.
2. Secretary Ajith Hegde read the minutes of the last AGM held on 21st September, 2014 and the same was approved by the house unanimously.
3. With regard to secretarial report, Ajith Hegde mentioned that, the details of activities under taken by the main Sangha, Ladies Wing, Youth Wing, & regional committees during the year from last AGM to this AGM separately in the AGM report. He thanked all members for their contribution in making the events successful during the year.
4. Treasurer, Mr. Chandrahas Shetty had presented audited Balance Sheet & income & expenditure A/C 2014-15 for approval which were already circulated with AGM Report for adoption. He also mentioned about the total money received as donation and expenditure done up to date for the construction work of our Cultural Centre He also mentioned about expenditure on objects of the trust like annual picnic, annual Sports, annual get together, education aids etc & he also said total lucky draw coupon collection its expenditure & balance transferred to Bldg fund. Account pass proposed by Mr Shashindra Shetty and seconded by Mr Kiran Rai.
5. Secretary Ajith Hegde proposed the name of M/s Dayananda Shetty and Co. as auditor for year 2015-16. Also mentioned that auditors has been giving various service like account writing, TDS return of VAT & IT, auditing of final a/cs, IT return, Charity commission compliance etc for several years to the Sangha at free of cost. Moreover he had been prompt & honest in all accounting matters including time to time advising us in that respect. The house felt that there is no need for changing the auditor and it was unanimously passed as follows:
 "It is resolved that M/s Dayananda Shetty and Co hereby appointed as the auditors for the year 2015-16 of Bunts Sangha Pune and the managing committee is authorized to fix the fees"..Proposed by: Mr Santosh Shetty (Yennehole) & Seconded by; Mr. Raghuram Rai. (SZ)
6. Regarding the proposal of change of registered office of our Sangha from F/16, Shanti Kunj to new address S. No. 104/part Village Baner, Pune-411045 for future correspondence & other purposes. It was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:
 "It is hereby resolved and approved that the registered office of our Sangha/Trust shall be transferred to our under constructed cultural centre, that is: Bunts Sangha Pune, S.No. 104/part Baner, Nr Mercedes Showroom, Mumbai-Bangalore highway, Pune - 411045, instead

of F/16, Shanti Kunj, Opp: GPO, Pune - 411001 and henceforth all the communication as well as all meetings of our Sangha shall be held at our new address.

Proposed By: Mr Shekar Shetty (SZ Secretary) Seconded by; Mrs Jayanthi J Shetty (Ex chairperson LW)

7. Regarding the proposal of sale of our office at F/16, Shanti Kunj, Pune - 411001, for raising fund for ongoing construction of our cultural centre. It was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:

"It is hereby resolved and approved that our office premises situated at F/16, Shanti Kunj, Opp. GPO, Pune - 411001, be sold/assigned/transferred to prospective Purchaser/transferee and proceeds thereof should be used and utilized for purpose of construction of our cultural centre, and managing committee shall be authorized and empowered to deal with the same and further to execute necessary documents in favor of prospective purchaser" Proposed By: Mr Prashanth Shetty (Glaze Tech) Seconded by: Mrs Sarika Chandrahas Shetty.

8. Regarding the proposal about the amendment in our Bye Laws for creation of the post "Honorary President" of our Sangha in view of immense Contribution for the development of our Sangha. It was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:

"It is hereby resolved and approved that amendments in bye laws of our Sangha as 3.2.D after 3.2.C for creation of post of Honorary President of our Sangha in view of immense contribution for the development of our Sangha and accordingly Mr. Jagannath B. Shetty shall be nominated as Honorary President and such Honorary President shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting and shall be of advisory capacity Proposed By: Mr Prabakar Shetty (Tamanna) Seconded by Rajaram Shetty (NZ)

9. Regarding the proposal about the amendment in our bye laws to establish Youth Wing as auxiliary to our main Sangha in view to promote social, cultural & educational activities amongst youth generation of our Sangha.. It was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:

"It is hereby resolved and approved that amendments in bye laws of our Sangha to establish Youth Wing as auxiliary to the main Sangha, in order to promote social, Cultural and educational activities amongst youths belonging to our Sangha. Managing committee is hereby authorized and empowered to file necessary change report with office of Charity Commissioner, Pune." The proposed amendment in the form of "Section 6" to be added / inserted in our Bye Laws as provided in Annexure 1.

WITH PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

10. Regarding the PMC notice for reserving the part of land of our cultural centre, at Baner for road widening & in exchange, receive the benefit in the form of FSI or TDR from PMC, it was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:

"It is hereby resolved and approved that part of the land our cultural centre, at Baner have been reserved for road widening & accordingly PMC has issued letter dated 29-12-2014 to obtain permission from the office of Charity commission to transfer the said land in the name of PMC, to receive the benefit in the form of FSI and TDR and managing committee hereby authorized to take necessary step to obtain such permission."

11. Regarding the proposal of intimation of holding AGM Notice & Reports by electronic media like website, emails, mass SMS, etc. instead of sending hard copy through post

which would cost our sangha not less than Rs 30-40 thousand per year towards printing & postage. Mr Sadananda Shetty (ex President) had expressed his view that most of our members cannot be accessed as they are illiterate & less privileged but subsequently convinced by the clarification given by secretary Mr. Ajith Hegde who informed that hard copies also would be made available at our registered office & those who want can avail it from our office. Then it was unanimously accepted in the house & resolution was passed as follows:

"It is hereby resolved and approved that henceforth sending intimation of holding AGM Notice & Reports and various notification regarding our sangha matters by electronic media like website, emails, mass SMS etc instead of sending hard copy through post & also hard copy shall be made available at registered office" Proposed by; Mrs Champa Surendra Shetty (NZ LW Chairperson) Seconded by: Mr Rohan Shetty (YW Secretary)

12. In president report, Mr Santosh Shetty mentioned that construction activity of our cultural centre & fund raising work have been in full swing. Seven groups have been formed for donation collection & they are doing their best. Regarding construction activity, most of RCC, civil work, Brick work, internal & external plastering, roofing, laurite stone & FRB work on external elevation, Service floor work etc have been completed. Now tenders finalization process of most of interior work like Fire Fighting system, Plumbing, electricals, Air conditioning, acoustic system sound system, stage craft etc are underway. He also said, he along with some office bearers of our sangha had organized the visit of more than 200 philanthropic members of our community from Pune, Pimpri- Chichwad, haveli, Mumbai etc as per their convenient & collect as well as got committed substantial amount of donations for our project. And all of them appreciated our effort, hard work & dedication towards the completion of our dream project. We humbly request all members to donate generously, so as to make the long standing dream of our sangha come true.
13. Adv Kolhe, our legal advisor was present at the meeting & in his speech, he said up till now 36 change reports consisting of change in Managing committees, change in acquisition of property & change in bye laws of our sangha up to 31-12-2015 were submitted to Charity commission & all has been condoned for delay caused to submit them with the office of CC, Pune and out of 36 change reports, 9 were accepted by CC, that means cleared up to 31-12-1999 By filing the said change reports, we have updated records of our sangha with office of CC since the inception of our sangha.

Since no other item was raised by the house the meeting was adjourned with vote of Thanks. by Secretary Ajith Hegde & national anthem.

ANNEXURE 1

Section - 6 Youth Wing Committee

- 6.1 Object:** There shall be youth wing of the Sangha as auxiliary of the main Sangha to encourage social interest between the youth members of our Sangha and to generally promote social educational and cultural advancement of youth belonging to our Sangha, in furtherance of the aims and objects of the Sangha.
- 6.2 Committee:**
- 6.2.1** The management of the Youth Wing shall be vested in the committee consisting of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and 8 other member selected by the youth members of the Sangha at the AGM at which managing council of the Sangha shall be elected.
- 6.2.2** The committee shall hold office for a term of two years.
- 6.2.3** The committee shall have power at any time and from time to time fill any casual Vacancy among the office bearers and on the committee. Any office bearer or member of the committee so appointed shall hold the office only till the next AGM at which election of the President and the managing council shall be held, but shall then be eligible for re-election.
- 6.2.4** The committee shall function in co-ordination with and as complementary to and subject to the overall control of the managing council of the Sangha.
- 6.3** The chairman, the Secretary, and the Treasurer of the youth wing shall be the ex officio members of the Managing Council of the Sangha.
- 6.4. Fund**
- 6.4.1** The youth wing shall have its own funds received on account of grants, donations, subscriptions and otherwise.
- 6.4.2.** The committee shall open account or accounts in any nationalized Bank or Banks, which shall be designated as Youth Wing (Bunts Sangha) Account and shall be operated by the Chairman and the Treasurer of the youth wing jointly. All money received by the youth wing and other funds of the youth wing shall be deposited in such account or accounts.
- 6.4.3** It shall be obligatory for the committee to get prior approval of the Managing Council of the Sangha for expenses involving more than Rs. 10,000/- at any time.
- 6.4.4** The committee shall have the power, at any time and from time to time to transfer the surplus funds of the youth wing.
- 6.5 Accounts:**
- 6.5.1** The Treasurer of the youth wing shall cause proper books of accounts to be kept in respect of all sums of money received and expended by the youth wing and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place.
- 6.5.2** The Committee shall submit to the Managing Council of the Sangha quarterly statement of all income and expenditure along with the report of its activities.
- 6.6** Rules, regulations, and procedures applicable to election of managing council of the Sangha shall mutatis mutandis apply to the election of the managing committee of the youth wing.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Dear Members,

I would like to thank all the committee members sincerely for their co-operation during the year due to which I was able to perform my duties. I also thank Bunts' Sangha members of Pune for responding positively whenever required.

Bunts Sangha Pune has conducted the following activities during the year for the benefit of all members.

Annual Picnic: Members look forward to this event every year. This year we had organized the picnic on 17/11/2015 at "Imagica", adventure theme park, Pali-Kopoli Road, Off Mumbai-Pune Expressway. Around 200 members were participated and enjoyed the picnic. Since it was paid picnic, we had collected Rs. 1000 & Rs. 500 per adult and children respectively which includes Veg, Non-Veg buffet lunch provided at Venue. For bus transport & some members' total expenses had been paid by our sangha which costed total Rs. 53,200. Many events were participated by the adults and children. Kids enjoyed the day. Members took this opportunity to mix with the community members.

Annual Sports Meet: This year the sports meet was conducted under the Chairmanship of Mr. Vivekanada Shetty Averse and was inaugurated by chief guest of the day, Mr. B A Moidin Bava, MLA Suratkal constituent of Mangalore Dist, by releasing balloons into the air & our president Santosh Shetty was the presiding officer for said event. Members started gathering at around 8 am and about 450 Members and their family participated in various events. Apart of various athlete track events, the volleyball and throw ball tournaments were conducted on the same day and cricket tournament had been held at NCL ground at different dates. Dr Dayananda Shetty, KEM Hospital was our chief guest for closing ceremony & prize distribution function. Annual Gathering: Traditionally on the 26th of January, our Annual Gathering was held at Mahalaxmi Lawns, Karvenagar this year. This year we had a large crowd of about 2500 members for the function. The guest of honor Mrs Jyoti Shetty, Consultant

psychiatrist in leading hospitals in Pune who not only graced the occasion but also delivered the lecture on Stress management on this occasion. Around 150 to 200 members & guests were attended the function wherein mainly homemade traditional food of ugadi like payasa, manni, Pundi resa, patradya etc prepared by our LW members & served along with Veg lunch catered by caterer Mr Shivaram Pujary. All were participated & made the function grand success.

Annual Education Aid Distribution: We had organized Annual Education Aid Distribution program on July 16, 2016 at Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Sanskritik Bhavan at Ghole Road.
