ANNEXURE 1

Section - 6 Youth Wing Committee

- 6.1 Object:** There shall be youth wing of the Sangha as auxiliary of the main Sangha to encourage social interest between the youth members of our Sangha and to generally promote social educational and cultural advancement of youth belonging to our Sangha, in furtherance of the aims and objects of the Sangha.
- 6.2 Committee:**
- 6.2.1** The management of the Youth Wing shall be vested in the committee consisting of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and 8 other member selected by the youth members of the Sangha at the AGM at which managing council of the Sangha shall be elected.
- 6.2.2** The committee shall hold office for a term of two years.
- 6.2.3** The committee shall have power at any time and from time to time fill any casual vacancy among the office bearers and on the committee. Any office bearer or member of the committee so appointed shall hold the office only till the next AGM at which election of the President and the managing council shall be held, but shall then be eligible for re-election.
- 6.2.4** The committee shall function in co-ordination with and as complementary to and subject to the overall control of the managing council of the Sangha.
- 6.3** The chairman, the Secretary, and the Treasurer of the youth wing shall be the ex-officio members of the Managing Council of the Sangha.
- 6.4. Fund**
- 6.4.1** The youth wing shall have its own funds received on account of grants, donations, subscriptions and otherwise.
- 6.4.2.** The committee shall open account or accounts in any nationalized Bank or Banks, which shall be designated as Youth Wing (Bunts Sangha) Account and shall be operated by the Chairman and the Treasurer of the youth wing jointly. All money received by the youth wing and other funds of the youth wing shall be deposited in such account or accounts.
- 6.4.3** It shall be obligatory for the committee to get prior approval of the Managing Council of the Sangha for expenses involving more than Rs. 10,000/- at any time.
- 6.4.4** The committee shall have the power, at any time and from time to time to transfer the surplus funds of the youth wing.
- 6.5 Accounts:**
- 6.5.1** The Treasurer of the youth wing shall cause proper books of accounts to be kept in respect of all sums of money received and expended by the youth wing and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place.
- 6.5.2** The Committee shall submit to the Managing Council of the Sangha quarterly statement of all income and expenditure along with the report of its activities.
- 6.6** Rules, regulations, and procedures applicable to election of managing council of the Sangha shall mutatis mutandis apply to the election of the managing committee of the youth wing.

Charity Commissioner, Deputy Charity Commissioner, Asstt. Charity Commissioner, Pune Region. Pune, Civil Court, District Court etc.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Dear Members,

First and the foremost, I would like to sincerely thank the Managing Committee members and Mr. Santosh Shetty, President of our Sangha for electing me as the Secretary of this venerated Sangha for the period 2014-16.

The resourceful & energetic team of our managing committee led by our young & dynamic Mr. Santosh Shetty as President, have contributed to this power-packed and successful year. Managing committee met every month and committee members have been given the opportunity to participate, deliberate and contribute on various matters related to the Sangha's administration, activities & the construction work of our cultural Centre. This year too we had many activities for the members.

On the day of the last AGM Mr. Balakrishna Hegde who was the returning officer had announced that total 21 nominations had received for 21 members managing committee 2014-16 & he said all the nominations received were in order, hence no election was held. Finally he had announced the names of the newly elected MC members before presenting the list of the same to the president. As many as 250 people attended the AGM.

Annual Picnic: This is the one social event every Pune Bunts member looks forward to as it is a wonderful gathering in the form of an annual picnic. This year it was held at Krushnai Water Park at Donje gaon on 16th November, 2014 & about 600 members participated and enjoyed. The guests for the picnic was Mrs. & Mr. Jaya Shetty, President of Bunts Sangha Haveli. The Quiz completion cum prize draw aimed for fund raising for our cultural centre was inaugurated by our Hon. President, Mr Jagnath B. Shetty. The renowned Yakshagana artist & poet Mr. Vishwanath Shetty along with his wife were felicitated in the gathering. Members participated in the orchestra and every one, young and elderly danced to the tune of the same. Many entertaining games were organized with mouth watering food for breakfast and lunch.

Sports Day: Sangha Annual sports day was organize on 14th December 2014 at BMCC Ground & same was inaugurated by Guests Dr. Deviprasad Shetty, Belapu (social worker & politician) & Mr. Sitaram Shetty, Imm. Past President, Pimpri Chichwad Bunts' Sangha with colourful balloons and a march past performed by the youth. Around 750 to 800 members participated in various events. Games like throwball, volley ball and other athletic races were held on this day. Cricket was also organize on different date.

Annual Gathering: Traditionally on the 26th of January, our Annual Gathering was held at Mahalaxmi Lawns, Karvenagar this year. This year we had a large crowd of about 3000 members for the function. Mr. Vinay Hegde, President Nitte Education Trust was the Chief Guest for the function & Mr. Sudhir V. Shetty, CMD of Charisma Group of Companies, Mr. Shashikiran Shetty, CMD of AllCargo Logistics & Mr. Karnire Vishwanath Shetty, President of Bunts' Sangha Mumbai were the Guest of Honors. All our guests were felicitated with mementos by our President. After paying a visit to the on-going construction of our cultural Bhavan, all of them appreciated the work-in-progress of the same under the leadership of our president and his team. President Mr. Santosh Shetty announced the formation of the Youth Wing for our main Sangha with a 11 member committee led by Mr. Karthik K. Shetty as the first Chairman for 2014-16. All office bearers & members of Youth Wing took oath in front of the gathering to abide by the Bye Laws of our Sangha and pledge to extend their support to all the activities of the Sangha as an auxiliary of the

Main Sangha. Entertaining and colourful dance performances were organised by our ladies wing of all committees. 'Gunduraj Shetty Gold Medal' for the best social worker of the year was awarded to Mr. Karunakara Shetty (Proprietor of Hotel Samudra) for his immense service to the society. Members presented a skit "Tuluvera Nadathe" which depicted the essences of our traditional, cultural & historic heritage. The programme culminated with the announcement of the Quiz contest winners by our president followed by a community dinner.

Annual Education Aid Distribution: We had organized **Annual Education Aid Distribution** program on 28th, June 2015 at Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Sanskritik Bhavan at Ghole Road. Mr. Prakash Shetty, CMD of MRG Group of Co's, Bangalore was the Chief Guest for the function with the audience of 350. We have supported students of our community for their education this year by donating more than Rs 5,50,000 to around 110 needy students & had also felicitated Ms. Harshitha H Shetty with the scholarship of Rs 25,000 for securing 1st rank in MH-CET (Medical-exam) 2015 followed by a sumptuous lunch.

In addition to social & educational activities, as a part of charity activities, we organized 'Annadhana' at lunch for 150 senior citizens of Mahatoshri Vradhashrama, Karvenagar, on 24th October, 2014, under the leadership of Mr. Chandrashekar Shetty, Edu. & Social Welfare Chairman. Many members from MC, LW, & regional Committees were present for the same. During the Palkhi procession, we had organized free distribution of biscuits, fruits and eatables to around 4000 warkaris under the personal supervision of our President with the help of many members's establishments like Hotel Sudama, Hotel Bamboo House, Vaishali, Symphony, etc. We have also donated Rs 13,000 as medical help to Mr. Harishchandra Shetty, working as waiter in Pritvi Restaurant at Kothrud for clearing hospital bills for his wife's surgery.

Website & Addressograph: Under the leadership of Mr. Prashant Shetty, we have revived & made a dynamic and user friendly website of our Sangha on which we are aggressively updating the addressograph. We have also added more than 500 new members to the Sangha. At present we have more than 1200 members' addressograph & photos on our website.

Bunts Cultural Centre: It is a pleasure to inform you that under the leadership of our President, Mr. Santosh Shetty, the construction activity of our cultural centre & fund raising work have been in full swing & all RCC, civil, brick work, internal & external plastering, roofing, laterite stone work on external elevation, service floor work, etc. have been completed. Now tender finalization process for interior work like compound wall, Fire Fighting system, Plumbing, electrical, Air conditioning, acoustic system, etc. are underway. The committee members under the leadership of Mr. Santosh Shetty had visited many eminent & philanthropic members of our community in Pune, Pimpri Chichwad & Mumbai & were able to collect substantial amount of donations from them. We had organized site visit of more than 75 eminent people from Pimpri Chichwad & Haveli Bunts Sangha on 25th February, 2015, who appreciated our effort & hard work and showed their inclination towards building fund donation. We humbly request all philanthropic members to donate generously, so as to make the long standing dream of the Pune Bunts to come true.

Resolutions during the period; we had taken some policy decision & passed few resolutions during the period of 2014-15 in our MC Meeting for AGM approval, they are;

- a. Since our office premises has not been used for neither meetings nor for any other purposes, hence planning to sell the same in the near future for want of fund for our construction. After thorough deliberation & discussion, "It was unanimously resolved

that all our future communication with Sangha/Trust to be transferred to our being constructed cultural centre, that is: Bunts' Sangha Pune, S.No. 104/part Baner, Nr Mercedes Showroom, Mumbai-Bangalore Highway, Village Baner, Pune - 411045. Resolution to this effect was passed in the MC meeting held on 9-03-2015.

- b. Since we are badly in need of fund for our construction of our cultural centre & after thorough deliberation & discussion, "It is hereby unanimously resolved & approved that our office premises situated at F/16, Shanti Kunj, Opp. GPO, Pune-411001, be sold/assigned/transferred to & proceeds thereof should be used & utilized for purpose of construction of our cultural centre, & managing committee shall be authorized & empowered to deal with the same and further to execute necessary documents in favour of the prospective purchaser
- c. In view to promote social, cultural & educational activities amongst youth generation of our Sangha "It was unanimously resolved to form Youth Wing of 11 members as auxiliary of our Sangha. All youth members of our Sangha will be members of the youth wing". Resolution to this effect was passed in the MC meeting held on 5-02-2014.
- d) Mr. Jagnath B. Shetty who is our immediate past president, has been associated with our Sangha from its inception, immensely contributed towards the development and expansion of our Sangha & he is a highly respected member in our entire community. Therefore it was unanimously resolved in the MC meeting held on 28-09-2014 that Mr. Jagnath B. Shetty is hereby nominated as Honorary President of our Sangha for the term of 2 years & such President shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting & shall be in advisory capacity only.

Compliance with office of joint Charity Commission, Pune: Under the leadership of Mr. Ganesh Shetty, updating work with charity commissioner through our Advocate Mr. Sanjay Kolhe is in full swing. Up till now 36 change reports consisting of change in Managing committees, change in acquisition of property & change in bye laws of our Sangha were prepared & submitted to Charity commission by Adv. Kolhe. Now, the Charity commission has been pleased to condoned all said change reports for delay caused to submit them with their office. By filing the said change reports, we have updated records of our sangha with office of Charity commission since the inception of our Sangha. This work is as good as cleaning the mess as this was to be done from time to time from the beginning.

Fund raising by Quiz competition cum prize draw coupons: We have amassed substantial fund for our cultural centre by organizing Quiz competition cum prize draw coupons which was drawn at our Annual Gathering 2015. Each coupon was sold at the cost of Rs 250 few months prior to the function & total prize money was around 25 lakhs consisting of a four wheeler, two wheelers, gold coins etc, conducted under the guidance Mr. Praveen Shetty Puttur & Mr. Dinesh Shetty, Chairman NZ.

Independence celebration: On 15th, August 2015, we had organized flag hoisting programme at our site, Baner by the Chief Guest Mr. Ravi Shetty Mudambailu, President Tulu Koota, Qatar & around 100 members participated the function which followed by high tea.

Medical checkup camp: On 6th September, we had organized Cancer Screening camp for women under the sponsorship & guidelines of Dr. Sujai Hegde, Cancer Surgeon, Ruby Hall Clinic in association with Ladies Wing of our main committee. Around 100 of our ladies members got said screening test at free of cost which otherwise would cost Rs. 3600 per person. The said programme has been conducted at Ruby Hall Clinic which consisted of introduction by Dr. Sujai Hegde, our president's speech, talk by Dr. Anupama Mane and Q&A Session, etc. followed by lunch.

Ladies Wing of main Sangha: We had received only one proposal of 11 ladies members for their committee of 11 members under the Chairmanship of Mrs. Sandhya V. Shetty for approval & ratification in the main committee & all were in order, hence the same has been approved in MC meeting held on 5-11-2014.

Youth Wing of our main sangha : This year we had newly formed Youth Wing for our main Sangha and received 11 members for their committee of 11 members under the Chairmanship of Mr. Karthik K. Shetty for approval & ratification in the main committee & all were in order, hence the same has been approved in MC meeting held on 5-02-2015.

South Region: We had received only one proposal of 21 members for committee of 21 members under chairmanship of Mr. Vasanth Shetty & 11 members for Ladies wing committee of 11 members under the chairmanship of Mrs Geetha Shetty for approval & ratification in the main committee.
